The Department of Public Works is seeking applications for a [Senior Engineer/Project Manager](#). The Senior Engineer/Project Manager assists with city/civil engineering studies, project design, review, and inspections relating to City infrastructure related projects. The position has responsibility to oversee and perform design for Capital Improvements as assigned. Other responsibilities include reviewing easement documents, design and construction projects in accordance with state laws and engineering standards.

The Water Pollution Control Plant (Water and Resource Recovery Facility) is seeking applications for a full and part time [Lab Technician](#). The Lab Tech I works under general supervision and is responsible for analytical work related to the analysis of water, wastewater, storm water and environmental samples for the City of Muscatine Water Pollution Control Plant. Work involves responsibility for greeting and directing customers, taking payments, and monitoring proper disposal of compost site materials.
