## TWO PROCLAMATIONS, SWEARING IN ON AGENDA

Muscatine City Council to conduct regular council meeting Tuesday night

**MUSCATINE, Iowa** – The Muscatine City Council will meet at 5:30 p.m. Tuesday (Oct. 7) in the City Council Chambers on the second floor of Muscatine City Hall with a rather light agenda but one that includes two proclamations and the swearing in of Assistant Fire Chief Robbie Rock.

Muscatine Mayor Brad Bark will be reading and signing two proclamations Tuesday, declaring October 5-11, 2025, as Fire Prevention Week in Muscatine, and the month of October as National Disability Employment Awareness Month. Mayor Bark will also be announcing the Trick or Treat hours in Muscatine.

Bark will open the meeting by swearing in Robbie Rock as the Muscatine Fire Department Assistant Fire Chief.
