RE: Council Action – Request Approval to Extend the Completion Date for the Hershey Ave. Area Sewer Separation Project Contract II

### INTRODUCTION:

Langman Construction, Inc. is requesting an extension for completing the Hershey II Sewer Project until August 19, 2011.

### BACKGROUND:

The General Contractor for the Hershey Ave. Area Sewer Separation Project Contract II, Langman Construction Inc., has been working on this important CSO separation project since 2010. They are nearing the final months of completing the project. Originally the work was scheduled to be completed by the Spring of 2011. However, project delays occur for many reasons, and Langman requested the city's approval to extend the completion date until June 30, 2011. They now realize that they will not be able to meet this date and have requested an additional extension.

### RECOMMENDATION/RATIONALE:

I have asked Langman's representatives to provide the city with a FINAL completion date that is realistic as I am reluctant to go to the City Council a third time with an extension. As such, Langman believes with will be completed by August 19, 2011. This date seems appropriate since the contractor is making significant progress in separating the sewer at the final phase of the project which is W. 3<sup>rd</sup> from Green Street to Ash. Staff recommends approving the extension.
